Flower Shop Theme

A flower shop has opened at the daycare and preschool! The classroom has been transformed into a cheerful and colourful flower shop where the children can explore, play and learn to their heart's content.

Within this unit, the children will explore different colours and practise various maths concepts, such as counting, sorting and comparing. The shop role-play will also feature prominently. The children will take on the roles of florist or customer and learn in a playful way how a shop works. In this way, they practise buying and selling, waiting their turn and working together, amongst other things.

It is wonderful to see that this theme ties in so well with the theme for the nursery children. This creates a clear continuity within our childcare centre. In this way, we continue to build on the children's development together, whilst they discover new skills through play.

DOK Workshop

On Tuesday 21 April, DOK will be visiting for an interactive workshop specially designed for the toddlers at the playgroup. During this workshop, the children will be guided through a fun and educational programme in a playful way, with a focus on language, stories and interaction.

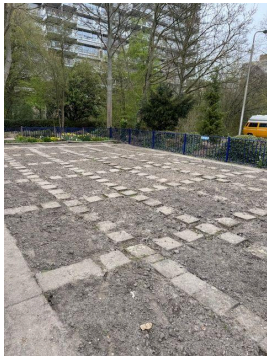

Group 6 visit the school garden in Tanthof-Oost

On Thursday 26 March, group 6 students were given an explanation about the school gardens, and on Thursday 9 April both group 6 classes will be visiting the school garden in Tanthof-Oost for the first time. Each child will be given a small plot measuring 4 metres long and 1 metre wide. We will be sowing and planting, and there will also be

regular harvests throughout the growing season. The experience and enjoyment of gardening are our top priorities.



School garden for the oldest kindergarten children and group 4

The gardening season is also about to begin for the oldest kindergarten children (those in group 2) and for group 4. We will be gardening in the school gardens next to our IB building. We start on Wednesday 1 April. The children in Year 8 will help the oldest reception children with the gardening. Please ensure that on Wednesdays the children wear old shoes or, if it rains (and there is mud in the garden), bring wellies that they can put on. By the end of the school year, the gardens will look less bare and you'll be able to

come and have a look.

Two-day study session

Our two-day study session actually began on Wednesday afternoon. Together with Springwijs Primary School, we discussed IPC. We visited each other's schools and looked at what we could learn from one another.

The Thursday and Friday sessions took place in Bennekom at the Natuurvriendenhuis De Bosbeek. There, too, we discussed our IPC teaching: what we're doing well, where we can still improve, and so on. We were also inspired by IPC trainers, gained ideas and new insights for preparing the upcoming unit, and got off to a good start with this.

Fortunately, the sun was shining, so we were able to have lunch outside and stretch our legs in the surrounding woodland.

They were two intensive, inspiring, yet enjoyable days.



Parent Satisfaction Survey Questionnaire

Last month, the questionnaire for the parent satisfaction survey was completed. Here is a brief overview of the results:

This school year, you gave us an average score of 7.7. A great result of which we are proud.

You indicated that your daughter and/or son enjoys coming to school (8.4) and that your child feels safe at our school (8.3).

One area for improvement is that we could challenge the students a little more at school to ensure their full development (6.8).

The students (in Years 6, 7 and 8) have also given the school a mark. We received an 8.2 from the students. This is slightly higher than last school year (7.9).

The students are satisfied with what they learn at school (8.5) and they find the rules we apply clear (8.7).

The 'bullying' domain (with questions about bullying) scored 8.5. Students generally feel safe in and around school (8.2), although 'other places' was ticked a number of times as an unsafe place.

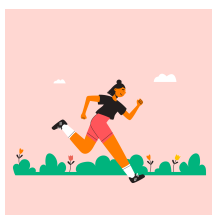
Together with the MR, the JMR and the team, we will be working on the findings and results of the survey.

TAKE YOUR FIRST STEPS IN LEARNING GERMAN AND JOIN OUR STUDY!

In the Netherlands, all secondary school students are taught foreign languages, including German. To prepare children for this early on, researchers at Utrecht University have developed an online lesson series to introduce children to this difficult language in a playful way. With this research, we not only aim to increase German language proficiency, but also better understand how children use knowledge of other languages to learn German.

Who can participate?

- Children aged 8 to 12 years old
- Children who hear and speak one of the following languages at home: 1) **Dutch**; 2) **English**; 3) **Polish**; 4) **Bulgarian**; 5) or **Russian**

What does participation mean?

- An online series of six lessons
- Children learn new German words and sentences in each lesson by doing playful exercises.
- Each lesson ends with a short online test
- A researcher will visit your home twice to perform additional tasks with your child, including tasks to test the German knowledge
- The study is set to start from **Spring 2026**
