

W4Kangaroo competition

The W4Kangoeroe competition is a maths and arithmetic competition that is organised at a lot of schools every year in March and is made by a lot of pupils. In the Netherlands, around 140,000 pupils take part at 2350 schools.

The competition is suitable from group 3 of primary school to 6 vwo of secondary school and also for HBO/WO students.

There are six versions: wizFUN, wizKID, wizSMART, wizBRAIN, wizPROF and wizEXPERT.

They involve 24 or 30 surprising questions, each requiring a spark of creativity, a flash of insight. Five answers per task are given, one is right. Which one? The first questions are easy, but gradually they get trickier.

At our school too, a number of children participated again. The assignments were quite tough, but some great results were achieved.

Certificates were distributed on Thursday, May 22.

The scores can also be found on these certificates. There will be a present for every participant and the best in a category will receive a game.



Next school year we will definitely participate again!

Leave of absence

Sometimes we get questions or confusion about leave. The following information gives you

more clarity. This can also be found in our school guide.

Except in case of illness, it is not permitted to miss school hours. Extra leave for holidays is not allowed. Children have 13 weeks of holidays. You have enough time to celebrate holidays



together. There is only one exception, namely when one of the parents cannot be away during any of the school holidays. An employer's statement must then be submitted. The management is obliged to follow these rules and in case of violation to report this to the school official.

You can request a day off for a child in case of important circumstances, such as moving house, religious holidays, a marriage of a family member or an anniversary. The form 'request for exemption from school attendance' can be downloaded from the website:

A request form must be submitted to the integral school leader at least one month before the desired leave. You will receive an answer to your request within fourteen days.

Extra leave in the first two weeks after the school holiday is never allowed. Unauthorised absence must be reported to the school attendance officer.
