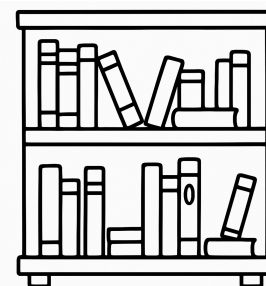
Daycare

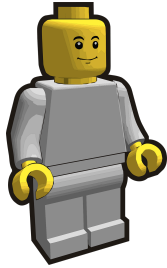

Caecilia Schipluiden - Making music is fun

Making music is fun, educational, and connects people! It has been proven that making music is good for brain development.

Caecilia in Schipluiden wants as many children as possible to experience how wonderful it is to make music together. Now that the school year has started again, it is also a good time to start learning to play an instrument.

At Caecilia Schipluiden, children can take lessons for all instruments found in a concert band, such as percussion, flute, trumpet, euphonium or trombone, clarinet or saxophone. You can start when you are 9 or 10 years old.



If you are younger or unsure, it is fun to start with a recorder. On the recorder, you learn to read music and make music in a playful way: a great stepping stone to one of the instruments mentioned above.

Would you like to see how much fun it is to make music together first?

On Friday evening, September 26, the youth orchestra will be playing in the Jeu de Boules greenhouse at Keenenburgweg 1 in Schipluiden.

The theme is Circus and admission is free. We start at 7:45 p.m. Will you be there?

On October 5 (or 6), you can come listen to Drumpack at the IJscub Vlietland ice rink in Schipluiden.

There you can hear what you will learn if you want to take percussion lessons.
