This is because study days start at 8:30 a.m. Do you need childcare earlier? That's possible! You can make use of the VSO (before-school care), which takes place from 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. You will soon receive more information about the study days and the application period via the parent app.

## News from the Participation Council (MR)

Meeting date: 30 September 2025 Key points from the MR meeting:

New MR member: We welcome TP as a new member of the MR, replacing BG.

Flying start: The school looks back on a successful start to the school year, with a complete teaching team and a successful work week for group 8.

New language method: The team is working with the

unanimously chosen TaalActief method. The analysis of the first results will follow shortly.

Focus on arithmetic: The results from June 2025 show that reading comprehension is on track, but that arithmetic in all grades is an area of focus for the coming period.

TSO funds expenditure: The MR is considering how to spend the extra TSO funds. A concrete plan must be in place by February 2026, with the school playgrounds receiving at least part of the funds.
