## Childcare in 2025

The 2025 rates are known. Although costs will rise in 2025, the childcare allowance will not be fully adjusted. Nevertheless, there is good news for families with an income between about €29,400 and €159,200. For this group, the co-payment will be lower and for the other groups, unfortunately, slightly

### Handing in surprises

On Friday, December 20, the lottery prizes will be drawn and there will be a Wheel of Fortune. Many raffle tickets will soon be sold by the students of group 8! On Friday December 20, the prize draw will take place at 11.30 am at the IB building. The children from RH will also be there at 11.30 am, you can pick them up there. The children are free in the afternoon.
