Christmas lunch daycare

In the week of 16 to 20 December, we will celebrate Christmas at the daycare! We will enjoy a Christmas lunch together with the children. There will be delicious sandwiches and juices, as well as the children being allowed to make their own snacks to eat with us. It will be a festive and tasty occasion!



Coaching at preschool

On Friday 13 December, the preschool (PSZ) colleagues will receive coaching in the group. This is part of working with the VVE method Speelplezier. During the coaching, the staff will be given tips on how to offer playing pleasure to the children.

Play Fun is a method that helps children learn in a fun way. We provide a safe and stimulating environment in which the children can develop well, for example in language, movement and cooperating with others.

An important part of coaching is looking at snacks. These are small games or activities we do in between, for example a short dance or a language game.

These moments are ideal for distracting children for a while, but also for practising their social and motor skills. It helps them to continue learning with pleasure, even if they need a short break from the bigger game.

We also watch how we observe the children during play. This allows us to respond well to what they need and help them develop even better.
