Looking back on the Christmas holidays

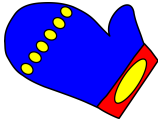

School play evening for kindergarteners

The kindergarteners have started a new IPC unit:

Reading aloud is for everyone

At DOK, there are reading sessions several times a week throughout the year. During the National Reading Aloud Days, there will be even more. For example, there will be readings not only in Dutch, but also in other languages such as Arabic and Spanish.

Why this focus on reading aloud?

Children enjoy being read to and it also helps them learn lots of new words, listen for longer and understand texts and stories

better.

Breinbaas - Leiden University conducts research - who's in?

Onderwerp: Lekker in je vel door Breinbaas!

Beste ouder(s)/verzorger(s),

Om leerlingen te helpen om stevig in hun schoenen te staan, doen het Sint Antonius Ziekenhuis Nieuwegein en Universiteit Leiden onderzoek naar het Breinbaas programma. Dit is een onlineprogramma met het doel om kinderen lekkerder in hun vel te laten zitten. De laatste jaren is er een toename geweest in gevoelens van angst, depressie en onzekerheid bij tieners. Als kinderen meer zelfvertrouwen hebben en stevig in hun schoenen staan, is de kans op de ontwikkeling van deze klachten kleiner. Wij willen daarom onderzoeken of het Breinbaas programma kinderen op de basisschool kan helpen om meer zelfvertrouwen en veerkracht te krijgen. Hiermee krijgen wij inzicht in wat helpt om mentale en stressklachten bij kinderen te voorkomen.

Het Breinbaas programma ondersteunt kinderen met verschillende dingen die moeilijk kunnen zijn voor hen (zie dit [filmpje](#)). Kinderen luisteren dagelijks naar ontspannende oefeningen, die onder andere gebaseerd zijn op wetenschappelijke kennis over hypnotherapie. De oefeningen zijn gericht op het versterken van zelfvertrouwen en veerkracht.

Doet uw kind ook mee?

- Voor wie? Kinderen uit groep 6/7
- Wat? Uw kind luistert zes weken dagelijks naar online ontspanningsoefeningen van ongeveer een kwartier en vult drie online vragenlijsten in. U vult één online vragenlijst in. Eén groep kinderen start direct met de oefeningen, de andere groep na zes maanden.
- Hoe? Via de digitale cursus Breinbaas
- Waarom? Breinbaas kan uw kind ondersteunen in zijn/haar zelfvertrouwen en veerkracht!

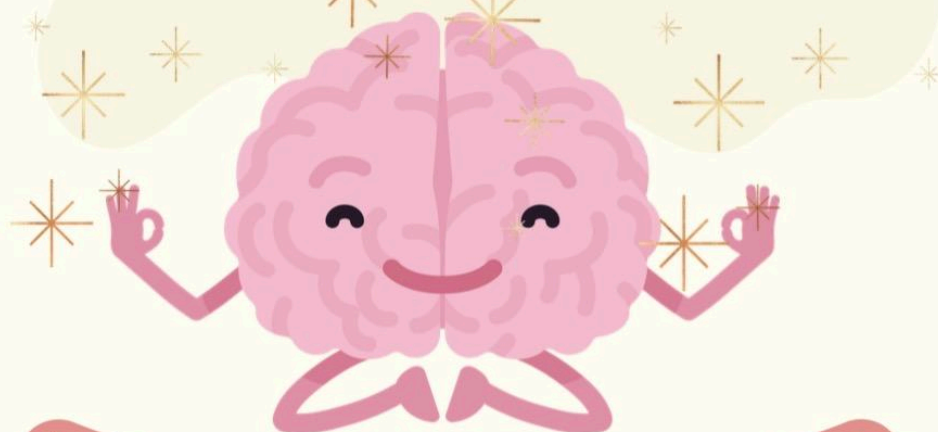
