


Group D is expected at school at 2:45 p.m.

Important information: Renovation of neighbours on Roland Holstlaan

We would like to inform you that our neighbours in the flat on Roland Holstlaan will be starting a large-scale renovation on Monday 9 February. The construction company is aware of the presence of our school and our drop-off and pick-up times. Nevertheless, the inconvenience will be noticeable. Parking behind the IB building and the parking spaces on Roland Holstlaan will be limited due to the work.

Our request to you:

- Please walk or cycle to school as much as possible.
- If you do come by car, please park only in the designated parking spaces.
- If necessary, park a little further away in the neighbourhood to avoid congestion.

Together, we can ensure that the square and the surrounding area remain safe for our children during this work. Thank you in advance for your cooperation!

Safety of our children: Your report is needed NOW!

Dear parents/guardians,

Every parent wants their child to arrive at school safely. However, we daily witness situations on the Roland Holstlaan and the Jan Campertlaan that are frankly dangerous. At the request of the municipality, the Parents' Council recently took photos of the traffic situation and the images speak for themselves: young cyclists are regularly squeezed between parked cars and moving traffic.

Why we need your help now? The Delft municipality will only take action if they receive a sufficient number of official reports. Without your report, nothing will happen. No "kiss & ride" zone, no one-way traffic, no improvements. Do you want the municipality to investigate this situation seriously? Please make a report immediately via the BuitenBeter app. The more they hear from us, the higher our school will rise on their priority list.

The difference between "just a second" and "life-threatening".

We understand the morning stress and the necessity of using a car. But what might feel to you like "just a quick stop" creates a life-threatening blind spot for a child on a bicycle.

We therefore urgently ask you to:

- **Park exclusively in the designated parking spaces, even if it means walking a short distance.**
- **Keep the passageway clear for children arriving by bike or on foot.**

By adding just a few minutes of walking time per parent, we can prevent accidents together. Let's not wait until a serious accident actually occurs.
