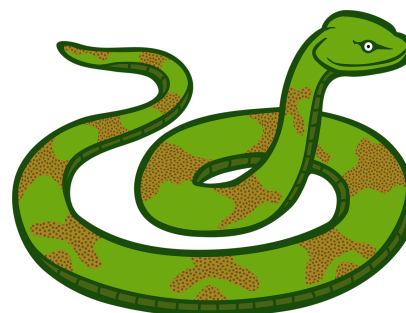

Spring break review

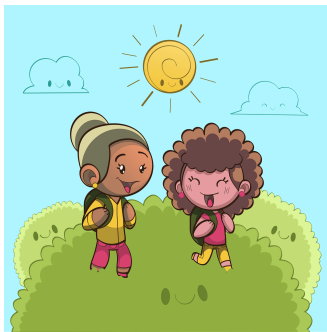

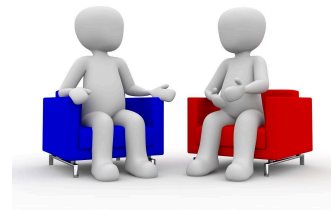

For example, the MR looks at how the school's money is spent and whether the lessons are good enough. In this way, we work together to ensure that the school is a pleasant and safe place for every child. You really do have a say in the MR: the headteacher can only implement important plans if the MR agrees.
