Collecting children at RH 917 and RH 919

At the RH buildings it is very busy to pick up the children at 3 pm. This creates situations where the teachers cannot see who has been picked up and who has not. We would like to remind you that we cross with the children in a line and send the children to the parents in front of the building opposite the school. We use the space in front of the building to stand with the children and their teachers so that we can send them to their parents from there. We therefore kindly ask you not to stand on the square in front of the school, not to sit on the coloured fences and not to stand in the area in front of the flat. We cannot cross safely in this way and it often results in us having to stop in the middle of the street because we cannot continue. That is why the area in front of the building is meant for teachers and their children. It is already very full with 6 classes and their teachers. You can wait on the pavement further on and we will send your child to you. Please make eye contact or wave so that we both know we have seen each other before we send the children. Everyone wants to be able to take their child home safely and the teachers want to send every child home safely to their parents.

We trust that everyone will bear this in mind.

If you know someone, please contact your child's group teacher. We would like to hear from you.


Wanted

If you order tickets, we will place the order with De Doelen and the pupils who accompany you will receive a number of lessons about the performance. They will be prepared for the story, the music, the visit etc.

After payment you will receive the tickets and we will meet in Rotterdam (everyone travels on their own, but if you buy a ticket for just your child we can travel together by train!)

There are still a limited number of tickets (many parents have already responded to the call in the mail), so do not wait too long to order! You can order until Friday 2 September.
